In ideal conditions, the 30 minute barrier was broken for the first time in a South Humberside 10K road race.

A fast, furious start, saw a pack of six quickly break from the main field. Led by the Lincolnshire County XC Champion, John Clark, the group sailed through the mile in 4.30. At 2K the group started to break up, first to drop was host club Mick Jagger along with the former Yorkshire 15 mile Champion, Carl Nightingale. With Clark relentlessly pushing the pace the Humberside County XC Champion, John Stephenson and Guy Fawkes 10K winner, John Beeden were next to drop off the pace.

Surprisingly, with Clark looking the more comfortable it was Copeland's Vincent Garner who made the break at the 3K mark, pushing himself into a ten metre lead.

This ten metre gap remained constant as Garner recorded 14.38 for $5 \, \mathrm{K}$.

Garner passed the 5 mile marker in 23.47 with Clark clocking 23.52. It was at this point that Garner struck for home, knocking over 1½ minutes off Carl Nightingale's 1987 course record. In fact the first seven including Nightingale all beat the old standard. First vet, Malcolm Martin (The Flying Ferret) recorded a PB for the distance, going through the mile in 4.38 he moved from 7th to finish in 3rd place. As Martin moves into the o/45 category in September, he must surely be a contender for Taff Davies 10K world record.

Barnsley's Eddie Kirkup ran six seconds faster than his o/55 win of last year to record an incredible 34.52, a British o/60 10K best.

The first three ladies all recorded PB's with Grimsby's Kathy Palmer repeating her 1986 victory. The Lincolnshire County XC Champion, Charlotte Newman was second with Kim Bennett, also going under the old course record in 3rd place.

The 1990 event will incorporate the Humberside 10K road championships. Colin Wright
